Greetings from your CABC Church Leadership Team

Bill distributed the income vs expenditure report. He explained that there was a question concerning the monthly income. He was able to reassure that the report is correct and current. Another question was satisfied regarding the income/outlay which was due to the taxes on the new church sign. Taxes were not known until the final billing was made. The final bill has now been paid. For additional information, see CLT Minutes of April 20, 2024. He added that each month we receive a reconciliation report for our accounts from Wells Fargo Bank and there has been no discrepancy reported.

Bill stated that while evaluating the extent of the mold issue in the hallway, asbestos was also detected. This changed the potential cost extensively. Tom has been working on this issue and has received estimates ranging from \$4,568.42 to \$18,694.41. It is unknown at this time exactly how much the insurance will cover.

The California Secretary of State has renewed the Church's status as a Non-profit Organization.

The Library has requested the use of a small portion of CABC's parking lot for a free dental health clinic on June 22, 2024 from 11a.m.to 2 p.m. The CLT approved the request.

The property in Arizona has continued to receive several offers for purchase, however, the offers are not acceptable and the property is not for sale.

The Sierra Butte Executive Board meeting was held on May 7, 2024 and continued the meeting on May 28, 2024 regarding the keeping of various financial books and proposals on how funds are to be allocated.

The second placards for the CABC sign have arrived and have been placed in the sign by Tammy Kaplan and Bill Winston. The final check for \$8,993.98 was mailed out "Registered Mail" and "Certified Mail" to ensure we have proof of closure with Stewart Signs Company.

Bill stated that the Pastor's Search Committee has gone back to SBC to repost for additional resumes for candidates for our Senior Pastor position.

It is once again time to begin working on a new Church Budget for the fiscal year of 2024-2025. Bill would like to propose that we extend the current budget with only slight changes where absolutely necessary. A.J. stated that he believes we need a budget that addresses only current needs, such as facilities, fellowship and pulpit fill. We will revisit the budget in more detail at the next CLT meeting on June 15.

Tom is looking for two more teachers. He said that he has been speaking with Pastor Thomas of the Spanish Ministry held at Cooper Ave. to teach a non-English speaking class. The Evangelism workshop that Tom and A.J. attended mentioned a program that SBBA will provide the church with a new Pastor and pay a portion of the Pastor's salary. They also have two grant programs per year that will provide \$300-\$500 for Evangelism events held in January and July. In addition, the workshop they attended provided us with a USB of the meeting. At the event they attended, the church received a \$1,000 grant to use on VBS. The graduate's names will be recognized on the overhead screen and also in the June 1 newsletter. Each graduate will be presented with a new Bible. 
